Option 1 “The Buffet” 142 seats

All-you-can-eat style buffet serving hot pot, yum cha, tempura, sushi, soba noodle, curry, salad etc.
You may be too busy eating to talk!



Option 2 “Tempura Tsuna-Hachi つな八” 32 seats

Famous tempura restaurant in Shinjuku, Tokyo.
Set menu with seasonal tempura, rice, miso soup and dessert (not shown).



Option 3 “Ton-Katsu Hanamura とんかつ花むら” 30 seats

A specialty restaurant serving Ton-Katsu (pork cutlet) and deep fried prawns. Set menu with salad, rice, miso soup and dessert (not shown).



Option 4 “Chinese: Nan-Goku Shuka 南国酒家” 26 seats

Famous Chinese restaurant in Harajuku, Tokyo, serving a course menu of a meat dish and a fish dish, with rice, soup, and dessert.



Option 5 “Japanese Western: Daijutei” 22 seats



A long-established Japanese-style Western-style restaurant established in 1948. They serve a set menu of fried prawn, hamburger steak with rice, soup, and salad, all in Japanese style. Western cuisine that is not found in the West!

Option 6 “Kyoto cuisine: Hamatoku 濱登久” 22 seats

If you have no time to visit Kyoto this time, this restaurant is what to choose.

A set menu of rice in soup with bean curd skin with a selection of Kyoto delights and vegetable tempura. Served with fruits.
